THE ASSESSOR DOES NOT CREATE ANY TAX LEVIES

County tax is levied by the Board of County Commissioners. City and town tax is levied by the city and town officials. Special districts taxes are levied by their board of directors. School tax is levied by their school boards. After the levies are certified to the County Assessor by the County Commissioners, it is then the duty of the Assessor to extend the taxes on property and create the warrant roll.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. "No personal demand of taxes shall be necessary, but it is the duty of every person, subject to taxation to attend at the office of the County Treasurer and pay taxes as required by law."
2. 2013 taxes are due January 1, 2014 Taxes may be paid in two equal payments. To avoid interest, the first half must be paid by the last day of February; the last half must be paid by June 15th. There is no penalty if paid in full by May 1st. Interest rates: First-half taxes March 1st to June 15th, 1% per month or fraction thereof. If full amount is not paid by May 1st, interest rate is 12% per annum.
3. Property will be advertised for sale for delinquent taxes in October. The sale will be held during the month of November. Personal property and Mobile Home taxes are advertised in September.
4. Delinquent taxes on Mobile Homes will be sold at Tax Sale, and title to it will be issued 1 year from date of sale, if not redeemed.
5. When property is sold at tax sale, the amount for which it is sold draws interest at the rate of 9% above the Federal Reserve Discount rate as of September 1st of that year and stays that same rate for the term of the certificate.
6. Property may be redeemed at any time within three years from date of sale. After three years, a tax deed may be legally issued.
7. Please bring your tax notices when paying your taxes. They keep us from missing property. If your tax notice does not cover all your properties, notify the County Treasurer. It may be assessed under some other name. Check your notices.

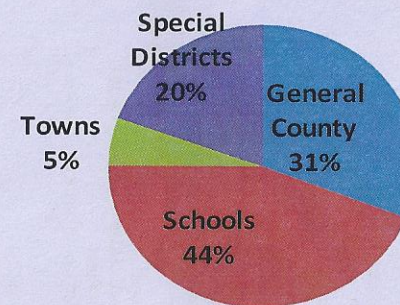
